

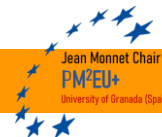

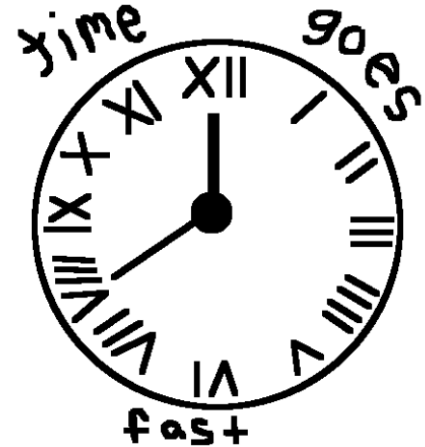

### Activities



## Two groups of activities:

### ■ Mandatory (twice a year):

- ▶ Teaching: Students, young researchers and university staff (twice a year)
- ▶ Training: Other public administrations workers, practitioners and the broader public. (twice a year)

### ■ Not mandatory.

- ▶ In companies trainings. Ad hoc.



## 02 Debate and increase the visibility



### One yearly PM<sup>2</sup> Talk (short workshop) including:

- Three speeches by well-known practitioners or professional from universities. In any case, experts on project management.
- A round table to encourage debate and discussion.
- A practical exercise by the attendees. It will allow them to put in value the concepts learned during the activity.

## 03 Research & Improvement



### Two well defined research lines:

- A systematic comparison between OpenPM<sup>2</sup> and others International well-known PMM.
- Collect opinions and experiences from OpenPM<sup>2</sup> Practitioners in different fields. **FEEDBACK** is a key-point to improve OpenPM<sup>2</sup>.

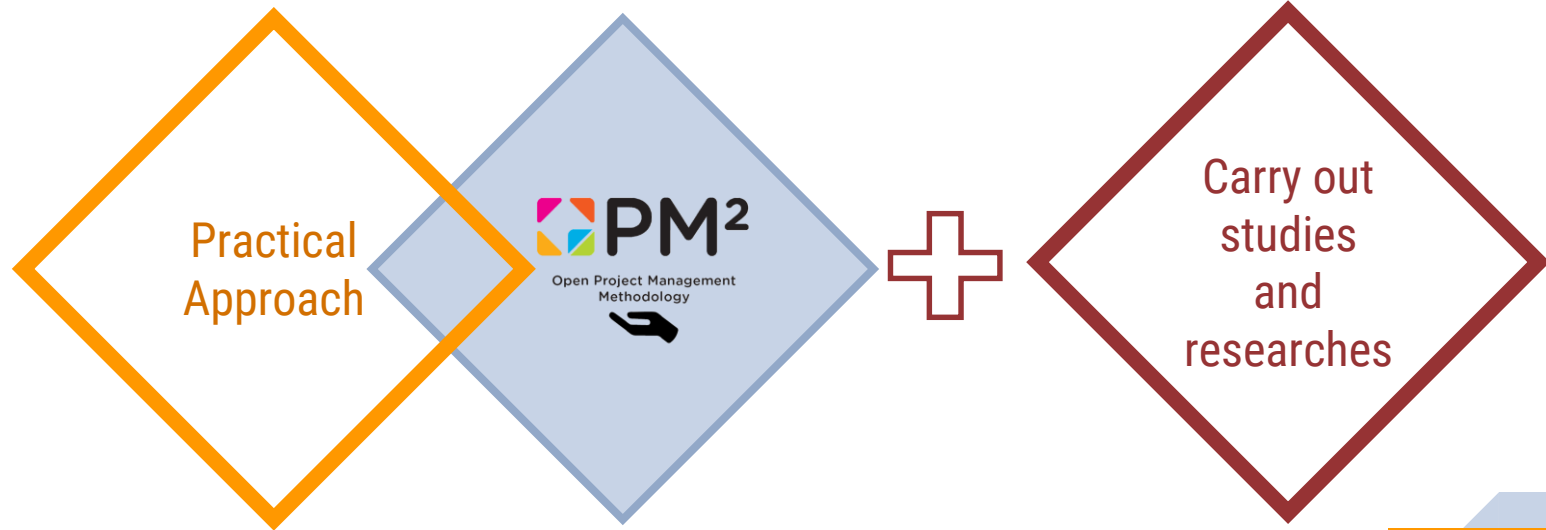
Some Thoughts (for finishing)

The future of PM2 depends on the community of project managers working together and exchanging knowledge and experiences.

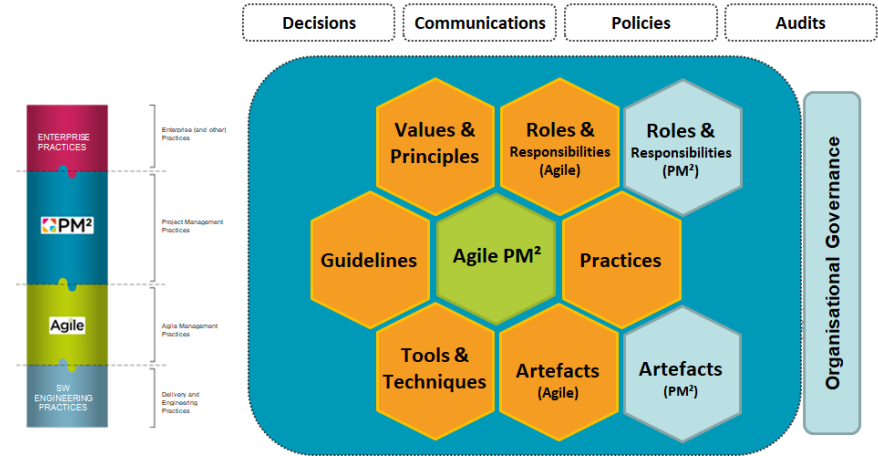


# WE NEED THE REST OF THE ELEMENTS
